## **2020 GADE Award for Educational Leadership in Doctoral Education**

### **Call for Nominations**

The **GADE Award for Educational Leadership in Doctoral Education** is given to a current or former faculty member at a GADE member organization who has made significant contributions to advancing doctoral education in the field of social work. Faculty distinguished by this award display a strong commitment to doctoral education and a demonstrated record of advancing doctoral education at the national or international level.

The winner of the GADE Award for Educational Leadership in Doctoral Education will be provided a certificate and a \$1,000 award at the Doctoral Student Connection Breakfast held at the 66<sup>th</sup> Annual Program Meeting of CSWE in Denver, Colorado (November 12-15, 2020). GADE is unable to pay for CSWE membership fees, travel costs or conference registration.

#### **Group for the Advancement of Doctoral Education in Social Work (GADE)**

The Group for the Advancement of Doctoral Education in Social Work (GADE) was established over 25 years ago to provide a forum for sharing ideas and strategies among doctoral programs in social work, and for strengthening efforts at enhancing doctoral education. The membership, comprised of directors of established social work and social welfare doctoral programs located in accredited universities, has established two awards for faculty for educational leadership and mentoring. The educational leadership award reflects our recognition of faculty who have made great efforts to improve doctoral education in social work.

#### **Award Criteria**

- Strong commitment to doctoral education in social work
- Significant contributions to doctoral education in social work at the national or international level through policy or program development, research or training on social work doctoral education, development and/or promotion of innovative models of doctoral education, or other activities that have had a demonstrable impact
- History of active participation in efforts to improve social work doctoral education

#### **Eligibility Criteria**

- The nominee must be or have previously been a faculty member at a GADE member organization

## Nomination Procedures

Self-nominations are NOT appropriate for this award.

### The nomination packet must include the following:

- Cover page
  - Name of the nominee
  - Contact information for the nominee (i.e., phone and e-mail address)
  - The current position of the nominee
  
- A letter of nomination from a Dean/Director, PhD Program Director or faculty member at a current GADE member school outlining how the nominee meets the Award Criteria (signed pdf)
- CV of nominee
- A one-page summary of nominee's activities in advancing doctoral education in social work written by the nominee

### The nomination may also include:

- Up to 2 letters of support by administrators, faculty, students or other social work professionals
- Abstracts of publications
