

## **ILLINOIS STATE UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF SOCIAL WORK – ASSISTANT PROFESSOR**

The School of Social Work at Illinois State University invites applications for the position of Assistant Professor in a combined social work program with approximately 200 students. The ideal candidate will be interested in teaching across the curriculum at the BSW and MSW levels. Illinois State University is located in Central Illinois mid-way between Chicago, Indianapolis, and St. Louis, and has a student population of approximately 20,000.

**Responsibilities:** Teaching expertise can be across the curriculum at both levels and expertise in research and/or field is welcome. The initial teaching load is two (2) courses per term which is four (4) courses for the first academic year.

**Minimum Qualifications:** This position requires an MSW from a CSWE-accredited program and a doctorate in social work or related field. ABD candidates can apply but must complete the doctorate within the first year of hire. A minimum of two years post-MSW practice experience is required.
