Two Faculty Positions

The Ohio State University College of Social Work invites applications for two tenure-track faculty positions, rank open, beginning September 2012. Social work is the fastest growing major at this research intensive university and we are growing our faculty to keep pace with the demand for exceptional scholars and educators. Successful candidates will be capable educators for our three degree programs: BSSW, MSW, and PhD. We are interested in recruiting the best candidates for our forward-moving scientific agenda: candidates who have demonstrated strong research and scholarship capacity. We are also recruiting strong educators who fit our redesigned curricula which will begin implementation in autumn 2012. The College of Social Work encourages education and scholarship related to implementing our vision “Embrace Difference. Seek Justice. Be the Change.” and translational or intervention research collaborations. Candidates must have or be scheduled to complete an earned doctorate in social work or related field; one or more social work degrees preferred. Applicants expecting to teach practice methods must have an MSW degree and at least two years post-MSW practice experience.

The College of Social Work at the Ohio State University is the longest continuously accredited public social work program in the United States. The Ohio State University, an extensive doctoral/research institution, is located in Ohio’s vibrant state capital, Columbus, within a diverse metropolitan region—the largest in the state and 15th largest in the nation. Successful candidates will join our 30 faculty and six field staff and engage with our student body of about 200 BSSW, 450 MSW, and 40 doctoral level students.
