The School invites applications for faculty positions at all ranks with a particular interest in candidates who are able to teach social work practice and/or have expertise in the area of intervention research.

Applicants must possess a doctorate (or be nearing completion of dissertation) in social work or a related social science field and a strong commitment to research, teaching and service. A master's degree in social work and two years of post-master's direct practice experience are preferred, although we will also consider candidates with complementary training and experience in psychology or a related field. For all positions, preference will be given to candidates with applied research interests relevant to disadvantaged populations and who demonstrate a commitment to the ideals set forth in the "University of Chicago Diversity Statement" (<http://www.uchicago.edu/diversity/>).

Applicants should submit a cover letter, a statement which outlines research and teaching interests, a curriculum vita, the names of three references, and a sample of 2-3 current writings. For applications for the level of Assistant Professor, applicants must include a copy of the dissertation or dissertation proposal. Review will continue until the position is filled or May 31, 2010 when the submission of all the required materials is due.
