Requirements include an MSW, minimum of two years full-time post master's practice experience and an earned doctorate, or completion of degree by August 2011 in social work or in a related discipline.

Preference will be given to candidates with research interest in one or more of the following: health, community health, health disparities, community based participatory methodologies; teaching interest/experience in two or more of the following: health, mental health, social policy, research.

Salary and rank for the position will be dependent upon applicant qualifications and experience.
