The University of California, Berkeley, invites nominations and applications for the position of Dean of the School of Social Welfare. The appointment will be effective July 1, 2012.

The School's faculty members carry out cutting-edge research of importance to the world today, and the School offers educational programs leading to the B.A., M.S.W. and Ph.D. degrees.

The dean will be expected to provide the School with academic, intellectual, and administrative leadership, helping the School to develop and advance its vision for the future in teaching, research, and public service. In addition, the dean will have responsibilities for fund-raising and for creating strong relationships with alumni and the profession.

Applicants for this position must have a distinguished record of scholarship, one that would warrant a tenured appointment as Professor. A professional degree or a Ph.D. in social work, social welfare, a related field, or a J.D. is expected. Applications are warmly welcomed from individuals whose experience has prepared them to make strong contributions to diversity and inclusion in higher education.

Nominations must be received by December 19, 2011. Nominations should include complete contact information. Nominees may be invited to submit a brief statement of interest and a *curriculum vitae*. An individual need not be nominated in order to apply; the search committee welcomes applications from all interested individuals. Applications should include a brief statement of interest and a *curriculum vitae*.
