



**College of Social Work
Director of Field Education**

The College of Social Work at the University of South Carolina invites applications and nominations for the Director of Field Education. In this pivotal leadership role, the Director shapes the Field Education program, ensuring students attain the competencies necessary for effective social work practice. Specifically, the Director oversees the recruitment and evaluation of field sites and assignment of students and faculty field liaisons to agency placements, develops and maintains appropriate records, builds and maintains relationships and communications with field agencies; plans and implements field instructor training and student orientations; develops field education resources; provides guidance in preventing and resolving student challenges and other challenges in field education; participates in appropriate College committees and work groups, and provides administrative leadership of the field instruction staff and faculty liaisons.

The College of Social Work is a premier setting to advance the health and social well-being of vulnerable populations through transdisciplinary, community-engaged teaching, research, and service. Its academic offerings include BSW, MSW, and Ph.D. programs, with an enrollment of approximately 600 students and program locations in Columbia [flagship campus], Charleston, Greenville, and Seoul, Korea. The University of South Carolina is a fully-accredited system, and is designated by the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching as a “very high research activity” institution with distinction in “community engagement.”

Qualifications for this non-tenure-track clinical faculty position are commensurate with rank and include an outstanding record in social work field education and curriculum development, program planning experience, demonstrated leadership in a field education setting, and a vision for the future of field education in a college of social work. The MSW degree is required, with a doctorate in social work preferred. Significant experience in social work practice with individuals, families, groups, communities, organizations, or social policy is required.

Salary: Highly competitive.
